

## How to access full software from NI, for free

Dear Student,

You can get free access to tens of thousands of dollars of National Instruments (NI) software on your own PC! NI is a global industry leader in engineering test, measurement, control and automation. For classes in mechatronics, embedded design, wireless communications, electronics, control, as well as design projects, you have access to all the NI software you need through our NI Academic Site License.

### 3 STEPS

To access LabVIEW, LabVIEW Communications, Multisim, and Ultiboard:

1. Request your Student Install serial number from your university IT staff.
2. Ask which Academic Site License we have:

- a. **The *LabVIEW Academic Site License* activates LabVIEW, LabVIEW Communications, and 50+ toolkits and modules.**
- b. The *Multisim Academic Site License* activates Multisim, Multisim Live Premium and Ultiboard.

3. Connect to the internet to download your software from [www.ni.com/academic/download](http://www.ni.com/academic/download).

That's it! Download the software installers, and activate the software using your Student Install serial number.

*Important: Your software will stay active for current academic year. After that time, you will need to get the next Student Install serial number from your university's IT staff for the following year.*
